I would also inform you that my wife has had cancer and although is cancer free now, has to make regular trips to the doctor as well.

Without insurance coverage we could not make it from payday to payday unless we give up our prescriptions, or at least some of them.

I worked 30 plus years in the coal mines so that I could feel secure in my retirement and hope you will consider my needs as well as my co-workers.
