I'm writing this letter to let you know what a hardship it would be on me and my husband if we were to loose our medic insurance.

My husband and I have both had cancer, he had prostate cancer and he's also fighting heart disease, I have had lung cancer and throat cancer.

My husband has a aneurism on his aorta and I have a aneurism on the atrium of my heart, we both have to be followed carefully with X-rays and blood work.

I also have lung problems, I only have 25% out of 88% of my lung capacity I'm on oxygen, medication and inhalers.

My husband takes a total of 9 medications a day for his medical problems.

As you can see if we loose our medic insurance we could not afford the medical care that we have to receive, it would bankrupt us.

My husband Lewis Bonham has worked in the coalfields for 27 years, at the time he retired he worked for Peabody Coal Company Local 1410 District 1.
