
Dear Judge Chapman;

I have high blood pressure, bad knees, tremors and a very bad back that will probably require surgery in the very near future. I also take a Beta Blocker to regulate my heart and pain pills just to be able to get around.

I cannot afford to pay more for my doctor visits and medications than I'm already paying, or I wouldn't be able to pay my other living expenses and would have to go to a home.
