I am 65 yrs. old and worked in the coal mine for 33 years.

I have suffered from anxiety and depression since I was 30 years old and still take medication for the condition. I have had three back operations, two knee operations, prostate cancer. I suffered a heart attack at age 49 and have had 2 stents put in. I have had Type 2 diabetes since the age of 35. Take 3 insulin shots a day. I am almost blind in one eye and have 41% use of my kidneys from having diabetes all these years. I have to sleep with a ~~CPAP~~ C-Pap machine. My heart Dr. told me I'm on my way to congestive heart failure. I am on eleven different meds along with my Insulin.

After working that many years in
