I am a 75 year old widow of a Miner who passed away in 1988. The medical benefits I receive from the years he worked are so very important to me. I have macular degeneration in both eyes with permanent damage to the left eye. I also have Meniere's disease in my left ear with permanent damage.

I fear another medical insurance would not cover pre-existing problems for a period of time which would be very damaging to my eyes. Without the pension benefits it would be hard to pay premiums. I have one family member left to help, all others have passed away.

The treatment to keep sight in my right eye is \$1200.00 to \$1800.00 dollars every three months.
