My name is Donald Van Cleve I am a 73 year old retired coal miner from Madisonville, Ky. I worked for 23 years at the River Queen mine in Western Kentucky for Seabody Coal Company. During my employment, I injured my back and had to have back surgery. After River Queen closed, I became unemployed.

At the present time I am now disabled with a fatal lung disease, Idiopathic Pulmonary Fibrosis, have had four heart bypass surgery and Rheumatoid Arthritis, which required me to have an infusion of Remicade every 8 weeks for daily movement. My wife of 50 years has diabetes, and is also carried under my medical insurance with U.M.R.

I greatly depend on my monthly pension and medical card very much.
