I spent 39 years in District 17 U.M.W.A. never missing work - worked when I should be home. Doctors would tell me to stay home and I would go on to work. Now they want to take away what I have worked for. Now that I am 76 years old and have blood pressure problems for which I take 5 pills a day to control. Also I have high triglycerides. I have had prostate cancer with radical surgery. I had both corotid arteries operated on and now they tell me I have a 75% blockage in one artery again. I had my heart catheterized before they would on my corotid arteries. I have had hip replacement and back surgery all within 7 months.

My wife also has rheumatoid artheritis, high blood pressure, and bad legs. We have to every 3 months for checkups on blood pressure and other problems.

All we ask for is what I have worked for. What are we supposed to do without medical coverage -- just die! They don't want to keep their promise.
