If Patriot Coal is allowed to rid themselves of the responsibility of their obligations to the workers who have given their lives to the job of laboring for the financial well being of a coal company then they should have to live up to the agreement they have made to the working men and women. I pray that this will not be allowed to happen we need our pensions and health insurance. Our very existence depends on the decisions on what this coal company is allowed to do. Please help us in this matter so that workers and retirees do not face such a terrible injustice.
