I am writing this letter on behalf of my husband, myself, & our Downs Syndrome Son.

My husband worked in the Coal mines for 23 yrs. He retired in 1998. Since then his diabetes has gotten worse, he takes 5 injections a day, he has Kidney Disease, he is blind in one eye, & legally blind in the other.

He also has heart disease, he had 4 Bypasses in 2007.

This is just my husband's illnesses. Our Son & also myself have medical problems

Year to date for 1-1-12 for RXs \$11,565.17, out of pocket \$3,300.84.

If the Coal Co. wins, my husband will die, because we can't afford his RXs, Hospital, & Doc. bills.

I am also writing this on behalf of all other miners & their families, that are in the same position we are.

My husband took less retirement pay, in order to keep our medical, Hospital, & RX benefits, so in the long run, we have already paid for these benefits.

I know it sounds like I am begging, well I am, because I am so very scared.

Shame on the Coal Companies, doing this to the people that made the money for them. There will be many people that will die, if they win.
