Judge Surratt-States;

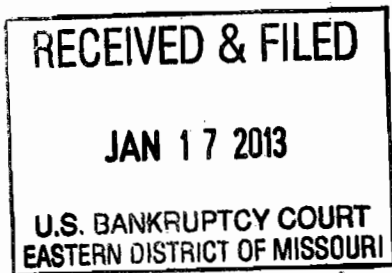
