My wife and I both have a lot of serious health problems that I could not pay for out of our small pensions. Without our health care we would be out of luck.


In conclusion, I sincerely hope that you will help us out and force Peabody to fulfill its promises to all of its workers. We all worked to make Peabody profitable.
