retirees and their widows.

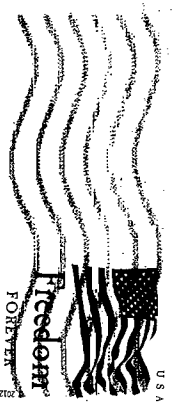
My dad fought very hard, worked very
