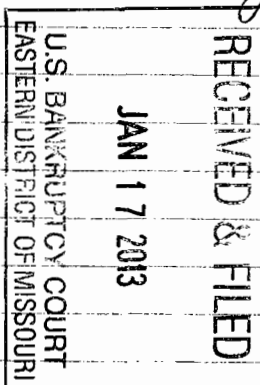


To The Honorable Kathy A Surratt States

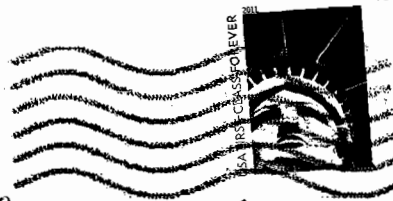
