have had a total of 3 more back sur-
geries bringing it to 5. The left
knee injured in 96 had to be re-
placed in Feb. 2008. Now the right
knee needs replacing but my
back is too bad to undergo another
knee replacement because of the
therapy involved.

I am covered up in Arthritis from neck to bottom of my feet use two meds. for that and then only get some relief. All this was brought on by my years of underground work for Peabody Coal Co. for which they could care less about me & thousands of others that gave their all for Peabody and many wound up like me or worse. One of my fellow workers pain was so bad he over dosed on pain med just trying to get relief and died had had. Here is a Corp. one of the largest in the world and richest and does not want to do what they promised in writing to do Pension and health care from cradle to grave. But to them this is only words with no meaning. I have made copies of the contract and sent them to the judge in New York which you have know.

I will soon become unable to walk much at all the way it looks now. But I guess Peabody could care less. On the other side of my life my wife of 48 wonderful years has been Diag. with a brain tumor and is cancer she is at present taking chemo and radiation tumor is called Glioblastoma I don't know if this is even close to the correct spelling. Judge taking away my earned benefits would be like murder on Peabody's behalf. Judge losing my earned and promised pension and health benefits the only means I have to treat and hopefully save my wife's life is unthinkable. And all this is being ask to be done by the richest coal co. in the world. It is hard to even think of how I would live with out my wife and the meds. I have to take daily just to get thru.

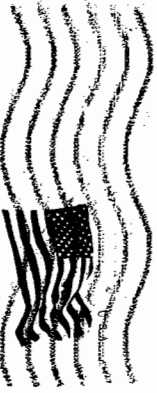
