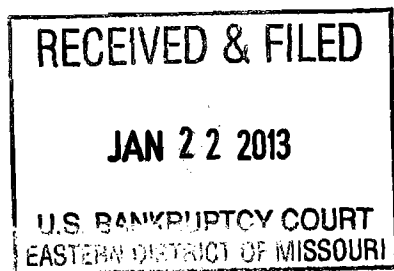


Your Honor,

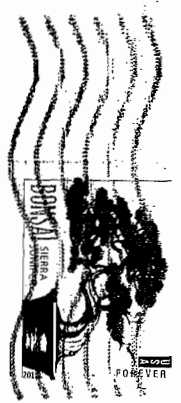
