To: The Honorable Kathy A. Sworatt - State's

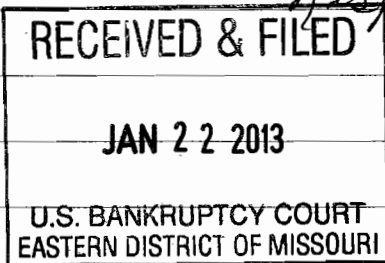
My late husband - Robert A. Coppage -
