Peabody Energy was reported on the news ^{having} one of the most profit margins in the United States.

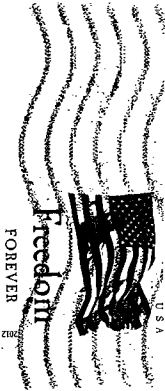
Mike retired with a pension of \$904 a month and health care insurance for life. That is our retirement our health care, we certainly couldn't live on \$904 a month.
