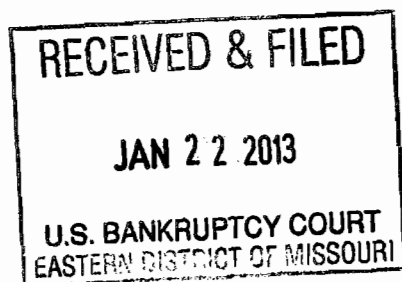
To Whom It May Concern:

I would appreciate, you thinking this situation over; before you make a final ruling on this matter.

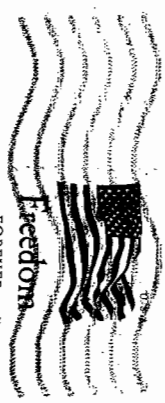
