They are just about taking a third of my check now, now they want to take all the promises they made to me after I gave them 35yrs. of my life

I kept my promise I went underground everyday of my job and did my best for them because they made promises to me they would take care of me and now they want to break the promises to me and others. It's not fair. I worked hard for them. I kept my word so should they. Their not only hurting us. We get up everyday worried about what's going to happen to us if we lose what we got. If we had to try to buy a policy no one would write it and if so the premium would be over a 1100.00 a month we can't afford that. We retired salary people have no one to stand up and speak for us. we hope and Pray that you as a Judge will see that we are protected from this hardship.
