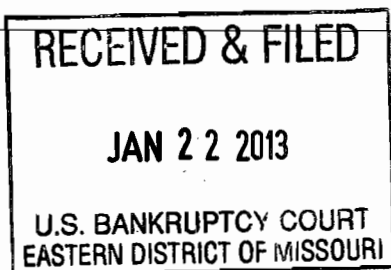


To The Honorable Kathy A. Surratt-States

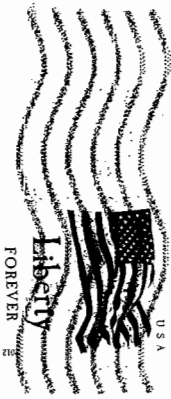
