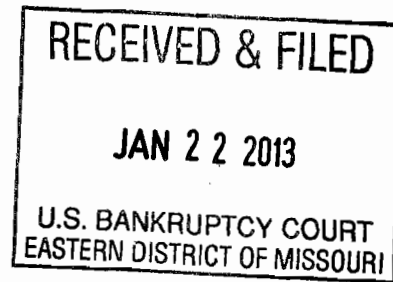

When I retired, I was guaranteed health insurance benefits as long as I and/or my spouse lived and I feel those promises are in jeopardy of being negated on. I am in hopes you will review the concerns of myself and other individuals on this matter and rule in our favor.

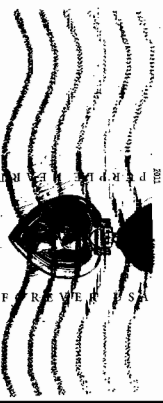
