I retired in Jan. 1998 due to mine closure by Peabody Coal. I then received my Health Card under the terms of the BCOA Contract 20 years and out and 55 yrs. of age.

About 4 years ago I received a new Health Card from Patriot Coal to whom (I have never worked). I knew that something was not right, and today I plainly see what it was. It was the beginning of an attempt to dump all employees by denying them their benefits, in which they gave the best years of their lives to obtain.

it will be devastating to the life  
and welfare of these who have  
earned and are entitled to these  
benefits.

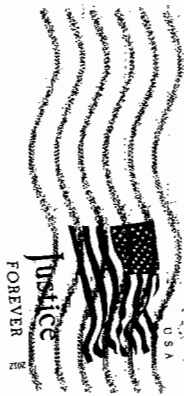
