My husband worked for Arch of Illinois,
for twenty years; Arch of Il. is now Patriot coal.

He took a cut in his pension when he
retired. So that I would have a pension and
insurance. The pension is only \$200.⁰⁰ a month,
but the insurance is priceless.

Last year I was in a car wreck one leg
surgery cost \$195,000.⁰⁰. I needed titanium bones
put in to replace the bones that were crushed.
I broke both feet, both legs, both arms, both
hands and punctured lungs with broken ribs.
I was in the hospital for 8 months. And I still
can't walk. On top of this I have high blood
pressure and diabetes plus depression.

My husband has been dead 7 yrs now.
He would have a fit to know the Company is
trying to do this.

Please, please don't let the Company
do this to the widows of "Coal miners".
