My husband was proud to work for Peabody, because he always felt that Peabody would always take care of their employees.

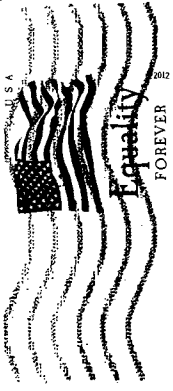
