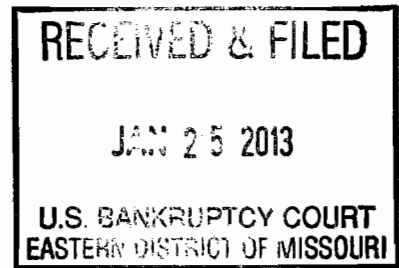


Dear Honorable Kathy A. Surratt-States
