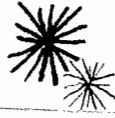

I am writing this letter for my husband who is a retired Coal miner and myself. When he retired he was promised by Peabody a pension and medical coverage for us.

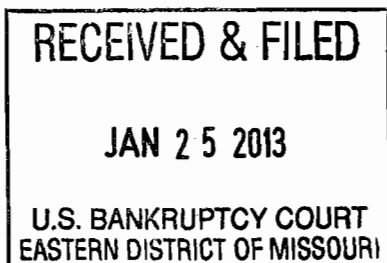
He is in his early 80's and planned to live out his life in security and peace based on these promises.
