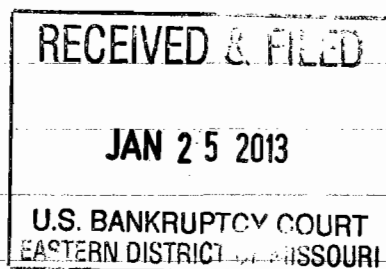
I was working for Arch Coal when
