& family.

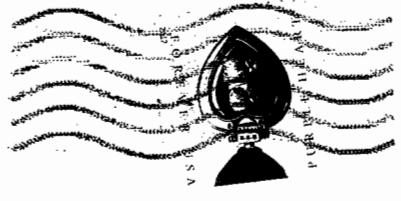
I hope you can
