have to worry about whether  
or not I'd have insurance.

He was my everything as was  
I to him.

I am disabled. I need my  
insurance. Part of my problems

physically are covered by workers  
comp. My neck and lower back.

The rest I need the insurance  
through Patriot/Highland/Peabody.

Yes I have medicare but it  
doesn't cover everything and it  
due to cuts is getting worse.

I just had hip replacement  
surgery on Dec 10th, 2012.

My orthopedic Dr. said I  
may need knee surgery next.  
Believe me I'd like to not  
have another surgery anytime  
soon. With the surgeries I've  
had on my neck (3) and my  
lower back (3) and now my  
hip replacement, I'm not  
a fan of surgery.

underground all these years was very stressful. But the jobs he had there were many, I am sure there wasn't anything he could not do underground in that mine.

We were married Dec 17, 1977.

He lived to our 33rd Anniversary. He had no more fight left in him the day after.

On Dec 21, me, my son, and his sister decided it was time for Hospice to take him to the hospital to take care of him. We just couldn't do it anymore. I couldn't face him dying in our home and having that ~~memory~~ memory HERE!

An ambulance picked him up, and I followed, he was put in a room at 2 pm, 6 hours and 2 minutes later he was gone, 8:02 pm.

Please don't let all those years that he and all the other coal miners and their widows or widowers be in vain.

These rights were not just worked for, they were sacrificed for.

My husband was proud to be a Union Coal Miner! I was proud and still am proud to have had such a wonderful

man in my life. It just wasn't long enough.

I know he died thinking I'd be ok. Not with him dying but that his job would take care of my medical needs.

Please consider your decision not just about me but for the men and women who worked and died for the UMWA.

For the men and women left to carry on without their soul mate, best friend, love of their lives!



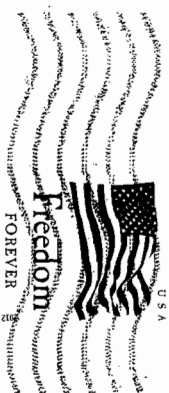
