I have immuno-deficiency;
after a lifetime of illnesses, infect-
ions, and hospital stays, I was
diagnosed in 1984. Although there
is no cure, it is treatable; every
four weeks I have to get/receive
a gammaglobulin infusion treatment.

It is tremendously expensive, and

would be impossible for us, to pay, should we lose our health care.

Harley worked so hard to provide for our family; working all the over-time he could, going to work when he was sick himself, because we were the most important thing in his life. He did all this, with the assurance and promise he had from Peabody, that we would always have our health. He did his job, your Honor, and kept his word, to be a dependable, reliable, and valuable employee.
