My husband, Ronald Steven Hosch, has worked underground for over 40 yrs, the last 35 yrs. he worked for Peabody Coal Company. After Peabody Camp^{#7} closed, they opened Highland Mining Co.^{#9} (A Peabody Energy Subsidiary) in Haverly, Ky.

Peabody wants to go back a year and not accept those miners that retired in 2007, as Peabody Coal Miners, but (Patriot Coal Miners.)

We are 60 yrs. old now, drawing Medicare for 80% of our medical bills. We draw less than \$5,000. a yr. No one would hire us to do any kind of work. He has high blood pressure, diabetes and I have high blood pressure, arthritis, spinal stenosis, a plate in my neck, more surgeries than I care to think about. I don't know of an insurance company who would insure us and if we could I don't see how we could afford it.

Steve could have worked at any of the non-union mines around here for a lot more money, but he settled for less money and the retirement + supplementary insurance. He knew we'd have some security in our old age, if he stayed with Peabody.

I ask of you to please help us keep what he's worked so hard for all his life. Thank You Sincerely,

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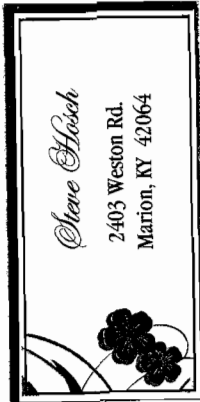
