
I know they (the companies) have sliced and diced; they close some mines and started others under other names.

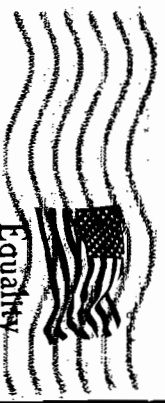
