It is one thing to do a job as dangerous and chargedous to your health as underground mining is with the understanding by doing so I and my wife would have full medical benefits at the age of fifty five. Who in the world would work seven to eight miles underground in damp, wet Conditions, breathing

rock and coal dust into their lungs Six days a week while the roof, rib glock and State fall in onion crippling you up knowing that no health care would be there when you get older and need it. We counted on our health care the Same as the wages that we agreed on lux our contract time and time again.

I am 11/2 years away from turning fifty five years old and getting the health care that was promised.

Please don't let Perbody do this to Us!
