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In accordance with the Order to Establish Procedures for Interim Monthly Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses of Professionals, dated August 2, 2012 (the "Interim Compensation Order"), Carmody MacDonald P.C. ("Carmody MacDonald"), counsel to the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors (the "Committee") of the above-captioned debtorsin-possession (collectively, the "Debtors"), hereby submits this Second Monthly Fee Statement (the "Fee Statement"), seeking compensation and reimbursement of expenses for the period of January 1, 2013 through and including January 31, 2013 (the "Second Monthly Period"). By this Fee Statement, Carmody MacDonald seeks payment of: \$18,385.60, which is equal to eighty percent of the total amount of compensation sought for actual and necessary professional services rendered during the Second Monthly Period. No reimbursement of expenses is requested in connection with such services.

Services Rendered and Disbursements Incurred

1. Attached as <u>Exhibit A</u> is a summary of the services rendered and compensation sought, by project category, for the Second Monthly Period.

To the extent an objection to the Fee Statement is received on or before the Review Deadline, the Debtors will withhold payment of that portion of the Fee Statement to which the objection is directed and will promptly pay the remainder of the fees and disbursements in the percentages set forth above. To the extent such objection is not resolved, it shall be preserved and scheduled for consideration at the next interim fee application hearing.
