In 2007 when Peabody, spun off Highland mine to Patriot Coal they took away the miners accumulated vacation days awarded for years service. Peabody-Patriot said the miners were working for a new Company now and reduced all the UMWH employees to 2 weeks paid vacation. Again, it would be "worth it" to give up their vacation time to retire with the health care benefits promised by the Company in the contract.

All UMWA miners ever wanted was safe working conditions, decent wages and their retirement that was in the contract.
