I'm writing to you about Patriot Coal Bankruptcy Case no. 12-51502.

My husband Calvin C. Bullard Jr. spent 34 yrs in the mines, in those years he has lost a finger, injured his back broke his left arm, sprained ankles and now he has black lung, and a diabetic.

If we were to lose our medical card there is no way we could afford to go to a doctor or buy medicine or to even purchase insurance. We were promised our medical care and pension after retirement. My husband gave his all when he was working he would work 16 hours a day sometimes and is this what he gets in return.

I have health problems too. I've had 2 spine surgeries on my neck, high blood pressure, allergies, and now I have a bulging disc in my back and I'm looking towards surgery.

This is not fair for Patriot to take everything away from the men when they gave them their all.

I ask that you consider the miners in your decision, we don't deserve to be forgotten.

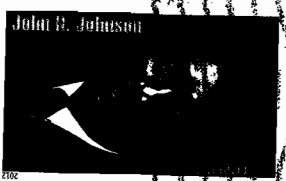
