- 4. The Objecting Parties shall make their expert and fact witnesses, if any, available for deposition during the week of April 8, 2013.

5. The Interested Shareholders shall file a response to any objections to the Motion

to Appoint by April 19, 2013.

6. A hearing on the Motion to Appoint shall be held before the Court on April 23,

2013, at 11:00 a.m., prevailing Central time (the "Hearing Date") in Courtroom 7-North.

7. This schedule is without prejudice to any party seeking leave of the Court to

adjust dates set forth herein as warranted, and the parties may agree to adjust any dates, other

than the Hearing Date, without leave.

8. This Court shall retain jurisdiction over any and all matters arising from or related

to the interpretation of this Order.
