1. **Akunuri Expert Materials, Wood Mackenzie Coal Market Service as of November 2012**: Although relied upon by the UMWA's designated expert witness Srinivas Akunuri, the UMWA has produced only a selection of the November 2012 Wood Mackenzie coal forecast report and has refused to disclose all portions upon which Akunuri relied. The UMWA's suggestion that the Debtors purchase the report, at a cost of approximately \$20,000 to the estate, is not acceptable.
