- 5. The Debtor has filed two separate objections requesting that the Court disallow Eastern District of Missouri Claim No. 29/GCG Claim No. 35 and disallow Eastern District of

Missouri Claim No. 566/GCG Claim No. 836 with surviving Claim Nos. 3965 and 3988 in the

amount of \$67,173.84.

Claims No. 3965/3988 for \$67,173.84 unsecured.
