## ORDER ADJOURNING IN PART AND SUSTAINING IN PART DEBTORS' THIRD OMNIBUS OBJECTION TO CLAIMS (Paid and Satisfied Claims)

Claim Nos. 1367, 1368, and 1369; GCG Claim Nos. 2095, 2096, and 2097); and the Claim of Southern Indiana Gas & Electric Co. (E.D. Mo. Claim No. 2581; GCG Claim No. 2015) (collectively, the

"Adjourned Claims"), the Objection is ADJOURNED to July 23, 2013 at 10:00 a.m. in Courtroom 7-North.

- 2. The Objection is SUSTAINED as to all Claims other than the Adjourned Claims.
- 3. The Claims listed on Exhibits A through C to the Objection, other than the Adjourned Claims, are hereby disallowed.
- 4. The Clerk of the Court and the Debtors' claims agent are hereby directed to reflect the disallowance and expungement of such Claims in their respective records.
- 5. Pursuant to Federal Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 3007(f), this Order is a final order with respect to each Claim disallowed and expunged hereby.
