In accordance with the Order to Establish Procedures for Interim Monthly Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses of Professionals, dated August 2, 2012 (the "Interim Compensation Order"), Carmody MacDonald P.C. ("Carmody MacDonald"), co-counsel to the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors (the "Committee") of the above-captioned debtors-in-possession (collectively, the "Debtors"), hereby submits this Eighth Monthly Fee Statement (the "Fee Statement"), seeking compensation and reimbursement of expenses for the period of July 1, 2013 through and including July 31, 2013 (the "Eighth Monthly Period"). By this Fee Statement, Carmody MacDonald seeks payment of: \$14,884.00, which is equal to (i) eighty percent of the total amount of compensation sought for actual and necessary professional services rendered during the Eighth Monthly Period (which is \$14,784.00) and (ii) reimbursement of \$100.00, which is equal to one hundred percent of its actual and necessary expenses incurred in connection with such services.

Services Rendered and Disbursements Incurred

- 1. Attached as **Exhibit A** is a summary of the services rendered and compensation sought, by project category, for the Eighth Monthly Period.
- 2. Attached as **Exhibit B** is a billing summary of Carmody MacDonald professionals by individual, setting forth the (i) name and title of each individual who performed services during the Eighth Monthly Period, (ii) aggregate time expended by each such individual, (iii) hourly billing rate for each such individual at Carmody MacDonald's current billing rates, (iv) the amount of fees earned by each Carmody MacDonald professional and paraprofessional, (v) year of bar admission for each attorney, and (vi) area of concentration for each attorney.

The blended hourly billing rate of Carmody MacDonald attorneys during the Eighth Monthly Period is \$340.78. The blended hourly billing rate of Carmody MacDonald paraprofessionals during the Eighth Monthly Period is \$150.00.

disbursements in the percentages set forth above. To the extent such objection is not resolved, it

shall be preserved and scheduled for consideration at the next interim fee application hearing.
