MOTION FOR EMERGENCY HEARING ON FIRST-DAY MOTIONS

NOW COME Patriot Coal Corporation and its subsidiaries that are debtors and debtors in possession in these proceedings (collectively, the "Initial Debtors"), and Brody Mining, LLC and Patriot Ventures LLC (together, the "New Debtors", and with the Initial Debtors, the "Debtors"), and respectfully request that the Court enter an order scheduling an emergency

hearing on each of its First-Day Motions, as defined below, pursuant to Local Rule 9013-2(A). In support of this Motion, the Debtors show the Court as follows:

Relief Requested

- 1. By this Motion, the Debtors respectfully request that this Court set a hearing on September 26, 2013 at 2:00 p.m. Central time, or at its earliest convenience thereafter, on the following motions that have been filed in connection with the commencement of the New Debtors' Chapter 11 cases (together, the "**First-Day Motions**"):
 - (a) Motion of the Debtors for Entry of an Order (i) Directing Joint

 Administration of Chapter 11 Cases Pursuant to Rule 1015(b); (ii) Making

 Certain Orders and Other Pleadings Entered or Filed in Chapter 11 Cases

 Applicable to New Debtors, on an Interim Basis, Pursuant to Section

 105(a); and (iii) Setting a Hearing for Entry of Final Relief; and
 - (b) Motion to Establish Deadline for Filing Proofs of Claim and Approving the Form and Manner of Notice Thereof.

Jurisdiction and Background

- 2. This Court has jurisdiction over this Motion under 28 U.S.C. § 1334. Venue of this proceeding is proper pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1409. This is a core proceeding within the meaning of 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2).
- 3. On July 9, 2012 (the "**Initial Petition Date**"), each of the Initial Debtors commenced a voluntary case under chapter 11 of title 11 of the United States Code (the "**Bankruptcy Code**") in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of New

York. On December 19, 2012, the SDNY Bankruptcy Court entered an order transferring the Initial Debtors' chapter 11 cases to this Court (the "**Transfer Order**") [ECF No. 1789].² Subsequently, each of the New Debtors commenced its chapter 11 case by filing petitions for voluntary relief with this Court on September 23, 2013 (the "**New Debtors' Petition Date**").

Basis for Relief

- 4. Local Rule 9013-2(A) provides that an emergency hearing—one occurring within 14 days of the filing of a motion—may be granted upon a movant's "written motion, setting forth the reason the matter should be heard on an expedited or emergency" basis. The Local Rules also recognize the need for an expedited hearing on first-day matters, instructing that such motions are typically heard within 48 hours of a filing. L.R. 9013-3(A)(1).
- 5. The First-Day Motions are essential to allowing the New Debtors to maintain continuity in their business operations and to aiding the efficient administration of the New Debtors' cases with the Initial Debtors' cases by ensuring appropriate procedures tailored to these cases and extending the relief provided in the Initial Debtors' first-day orders to the New Debtors.
- 6. The New Debtors therefore request that the Court permit the First-Day Motions to be heard on September 26, 2013 at 2:00 p.m. Central time, or at the earliest available date thereafter.

Notice

7. Pursuant to the Case Management Order, the Debtors will serve notice of this Motion on (a) the Core Parties and (b) the Non-ECF Service Parties (as those terms are defined in the Case Management Order). In addition, all parties who have requested electronic notice of filings in these cases through the Court's ECF system will automatically receive notice of this Motion no later than the day after its filing with the Court. Moreover, a copy of this Motion and any Order approving it will be made available on the Debtors' Case Information Website (located at www.PatriotCaseInformation.com). In light of the nature of the relief requested herein, the Debtors submit that no other or further notice need be provided.

WHEREFORE, the New Debtors respectfully request that this Court:

- (a) enter an order setting an emergency hearing on each of the First-Day Motions; and
- (b) grant the Debtors such other and further relief as is just and proper.
