### DEBTORS' OMNIBUS APPLICATION TO EXPAND <u>RETENTION OF PROFESSIONALS TO INCLUDE NEW DEBTORS</u>

Patriot Coal Corporation ("Patriot") and its affiliated debtors (collectively, the "Debtors"), respectfully request that this Court expand the retention of the Debtors' professionals to include representation of Brody Mining, LLC and Patriot Ventures LLC (the "New Debtors"), effective as of September 23, 2013, the date on which the New Debtors sought relief under Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code (the "New Debtors' Petition Date"). In support of this Application, the Debtors show the Court as follows:

### **Relief Requested**

1. By this Application, the Debtors request, pursuant to Sections 327, 328(a), and 363(b) of the Bankruptcy Code and Federal Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 2014, that their employment of the professionals listed on <u>Exhibit A</u> attached hereto (the "Professionals") be

expanded to encompass representation of the New Debtors, effective as of the New Debtors' Petition Date.<sup>1</sup>

### **Jurisdiction**

2. This Court has jurisdiction over this Objection under 28 U.S.C. § 1334. Venue of this proceeding is proper pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1409. This is a core proceeding within the meaning of 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2).

3. Venue is proper pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409.

## **Background**

4. Ninety-nine of the Debtors filed voluntary petitions for relief under Chapter 11 of

the Bankruptcy Code on July 9, 2012 in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Southern

District of New York.

5. On December 19, 2012, these Debtors' cases were transferred to the United States

Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern District of Missouri [Dkt. No. 1789].

Neither the inclusion of AP Services, LLC in the definition of "Professionals" nor other references to the provisions of the Bankruptcy Code governing the employment of professional persons is intended to modify the nature of the Debtors' engagement of AP Services, LLC. Similarly, nothing in this Application is intended to expand the application of Section 328(a) beyond the circumstances in which it currently applies to the Debtors' employment of certain of the Professionals.

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6. These Debtors' employment of the Professionals has been approved by various orders of the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of New York or this Court, with one exception.<sup>2</sup>

7. The New Debtors filed voluntary petitions for relief under Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code on September 23, 2013 in this Court.

#### **Basis for Relief**

8. Certain services to be provided by the Professionals will benefit all of the Debtors collectively. In addition, the Professionals may provide services for the particular benefit of one or both of the New Debtors. It is, therefore, appropriate that the Professionals' employment be expanded to include the New Debtors, effective as of the New Debtors' Petition Date.

9. The Debtors have requested the Professionals to file supplemental disclosures prior to the hearing on this Application. The Debtors believe that these disclosures will establish the Professionals' eligibility for retention by the New Debtors under Sections 327(a), 327(e), 328(a), or 363(b) of the Bankruptcy Code, as applicable, and will include, where required, the information required by Section 329(a) of the Bankruptcy Code and Federal Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 2014.

The disclosures by the Ogletree firm in that application will be supplemented to include the firm's connections, if any, with principal parties in interest in the New Debtors' cases.

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WHEREFORE, the Debtors respectfully request that this Court:

- (a) enter an order expanding the retention of the Professionals to include
  representation of the New Debtors, effective as of the New Debtors' Petition
  Date; and
- (b) grant the Debtors such other and further relief as is just and proper.
