1. On July 9, 2012 (the "<u>Petition Date</u>"), Patriot Coal Corporation and substantially all of its affiliated subsidiary companies ("<u>Initial Debtors</u>") filed voluntary petitions for Chapter 11 Relief. [*See* ECF No. 1]. Subsequently, Brody Mining, LLC and Patriot Ventures LLC (together, the "<u>New Debtors</u>," and with the Initial Debtors, the "<u>Debtors</u><sup>1</sup>") each commenced its chapter 11 case by filing a petition for voluntary relief with this Court on September 23, 2013. The Initial Debtors' cases are being jointly administered pursuant to Bankruptcy Rule 1015(b) and the Joint Administrative Order entered on July 10, 2012 [ECF No. 30], and the New Debtors' cases are being jointly administered with the Initial Debtors' cases pursuant to Bankruptcy Rule 1015(b) and the Order Directing Joint Administration of Chapter 11 Cases entered by the Court on September 27, 2013 in each of the New Debtors' chapter 11 cases.

2. Prior to the Petition Date, Jackson Kelly PLLC ("Jackson Kelly") rendered substantial legal services to Debtors in a wide range of areas. Debtors have retained Jackson Kelly – with the Court's authorization by its September 10, 2012, Order Authorizing the Employment and Retention of Jackson Kelly PLLC as Special Counsel for the Debtors Nunc Pro Tunc to the Petition Date [ECF No. 540] (the "Jackson Kelly Employment Order") – nunc pro tunc from the Petition Date to continue to render professional services in connection with (collectively the "Authorized Representation"):

(a) Environmental matters relating to the Debtors' coal leases, coal property, mines and other properties and installations;

(b) Mine safety and health matters, including alleged violations of the Mine Safety and Health Act;

(c) The defense of Federal Black Lung cases;

(d) The defense of West Virginia deliberate intent litigation;

(e) Litigation on behalf of one or more of the Debtors as a party plaintiff;

(f) Litigation on behalf of one or more of the Debtors as a party defendant;

(g) Local real estate and commercial transactions, as needed from time to time, which may not duplicate services provided by the Debtors' other counsel;

(h) Local legislative and lobbying services; and

(i) Representation of one or more of the debtors in arbitration issues.

3. The Court's December 5, 2012, Order Authorizing the Payment for Certain Services on a Fixed Fee Basis to Jackson Kelly PLLC [ECF 1677] (the "Fixed Fee Order"), amended the Jackson Kelly Employment Order to permit fixed fee billing for local legislative and lobbying services at a rate of \$2,500 per month *nunc pro tunc* to the Petition Date.

4. The Court's October 25, 2013, Order Granting in Part Debtors' Omnibus Application to Expand Retention of Professionals to Include New Debtors [ECF 4865] (the "Expansion Order") expanded the employment of Approved Firms, including Jackson Kelly, to encompass representation of New Debtors, Brody Mining, LLC and Patriot Ventures LLC.

5. In accordance with the Jackson Kelly Employment Order (as amended and expanded) and the Order to Establish Procedures for Interim Monthly Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses of Professionals [ECF No. 262] (the "Interim Compensation Order"), Jackson Kelly, as special counsel to the Debtors, hereby submits its Fifteenth Monthly

Fee Statement for Professional Services and Disbursements (the "<u>Fee Statement</u>") for the period October 1, 2013 through and including October 31, 2013 (the "<u>Fee Statement Period</u>").<sup>2</sup>

6. Pursuant to the Interim Compensation Order, Jackson Kelly seeks payment of \$225,684.52 representing (a) 80% of Jackson Kelly's fees for services rendered (\$216,132.56)<sup>3</sup> and (b) 100% of actual and necessary expenses incurred during the Fee Statement Period (\$9,551.96).

7. <u>Exhibit A</u> is a listing of Jackson Kelly's professional and paraprofessionals (collectively the "Jackson Kelly Professional(s)") that rendered services for Debtors under the Jackson Kelly Employment Order during the Fee Statement Period. Exhibit A includes, among other things, the total hours billed, hourly rate and total fees for each Jackson Kelly Professional, plus a blended hourly rate for each category of Jackson Kelly Professionals, excluding paralegals.

8. <u>Exhibit B</u> is a schedule summarizing the categories of actual and necessary expenses for which Jackson Kelly seeks reimbursement, and the total amount for each expense category.

9. <u>Exhibit C</u> is a summary of the hours and amounts billed by Jackson Kelly during the Fee Statement period for its Authorized Representation of the Debtors during the Fee Statement Period, organized by project type authorized by the Jackson Kelly Employment Order.

This case involves the contest of a Pattern of Violation ("POV") notice issued to Brody Mining on October 24, 2013. Brody Mining was one of the first mine operators to receive POV notices under the new POV Final Rule, 78 Fed. Reg. 5056 (Jan. 23, 2013). Jackson Kelly PLLC presented oral argument on several legal challenges to the rule in Pittsburgh in November 2013, and then prepared extensively for a three to four week trial scheduled for December 3, 2013, involving 54 separate citations. On December 2, 2013, the ALJ continued the trial indefinitely, indicating that he would rule on several threshold issues before commencing trial.
