REORGANIZED DEBTORS' TWENTY-NINTH OMNIBUS OBJECTION TO CLAIMS

(Black Lung Benefit Act Claims / Not Discharged)

Patriot Coal Corporation and its affiliates (the "Debtors" or the "Reorganized Debtors"), pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 502 and Fed. R. Bankr. P. 3007, respectfully file this Twenty-Ninth Omnibus Objection to Claims (the "Objection"). In support of this Objection, the Reorganized Debtors show the Court as follows:

Relief Requested

1. By this Objection, the Reorganized Debtors object to certain claims listed on Exhibit A attached hereto (the "Claims") because the Claims have not been discharged, will be paid in full (to the extent they are determined to be valid in non-bankruptcy proceedings) by the Reorganized Debtors or a claims administrator on the Reorganized Debtors' behalf, and thus are not properly payable by the Debtors' bankruptcy estates. The treatment of the Claims is specified in the Fourth Amended Joint Plan of Reorganization Under Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code [Dkt. No. 5139] (the "Plan") and the Amended Order Confirming Debtors' Joint Plan of Reorganization Under Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code [ECF No. 5169] (the

"Confirmation Order"). The Reorganized Debtors request entry of an order, pursuant to Section 502 of the Bankruptcy Code and Fed. R. Bankr. P. 3007, disallowing the Claims.

2. Parties receiving this Objection should locate their names on the attached exhibits. Any response to this Objection should include, among other things, (i) an appropriate caption, including the title and date of this Objection; (ii) the name of the claimant, both the EDMO and GCG claim numbers of the claim that the Reorganized Debtors are seeking to disallow, and a description of the basis for the amount claimed; (iii) a concise statement setting forth the reasons why the Court should not sustain this Objection, including, but not limited to, the specific factual and legal bases upon which the claimant relies in opposing this Objection; (iv) copies of any documentation and other evidence which the claimant will rely upon in opposing this Objection at a hearing; and (v) the name, address, telephone number and facsimile number of a person authorized to reconcile, settle or otherwise resolve the claim on the claimant's behalf. A claimant that cannot timely provide such documentation and other evidence should provide a detailed explanation as to why it is not possible to timely provide such documentation and other evidence.

Jurisdiction

- 3. This Court has jurisdiction over this Objection under 28 U.S.C. § 1334. Venue of this proceeding is proper pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1409. This is a core proceeding within the meaning of 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2).
 - 4. Venue is proper pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409.

Background

- 5. Ninety-nine of the Debtors filed voluntary petitions for relief under Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code on July 9, 2012 in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of New York (the "Petition Date").
- 6. On December 19, 2012, these Debtors' cases were transferred to the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern District of Missouri [Dkt. No. 1789].
- 7. The bar date for filing proofs of claim against these Debtors was December 14, 2012 [Dkt. No. 1388].
- 8. On March 1, 2013, the Court entered its Order Establishing Procedures for Claims Objections [Dkt. No. 3021].
- 9. Debtors Brody Mining, LLC and Patriot Ventures LLC filed voluntary petitions for relief under Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code on September 23, 2013 in this Court. The bar date for filing proofs of claim against these Debtors was October 24, 2013.
- 10. On December 17, 2013, the Court confirmed the Debtors' Fourth Amended Plan of Reorganization (the "Plan") [Dkt. No. 5169]. The Effective Date occurred on December 18, 2013.

Objection and Argument

11. The Debtors object to the Claims identified on Exhibit A, because the enforceability of the Claims is governed by the Plan and the Confirmation Order. ¹ Because the

¹ Certain creditors listed on Exhibit A may be clients of one or more of the law firms representing the Debtors. Any dispute regarding this Objection will be handled by attorneys for the Debtors from a law firm that does not represent the applicable creditor.

Debtors' bankruptcy estates are not liable for the Claims, the Claims should be disallowed, without prejudice to the claimants' rights to recover in non-bankruptcy proceedings.

- 12. Each of the claims arises under the Federal Mine Safety and Health Act of 1977, also known as the Black Lung Benefit Act, 30 U.S.C. §§ 901-944 (the "BLBA").
- 13. In an order dated August 2, 2012 [Dkt. No. 253], the Court modified the automatic stay to permit claimants to pursue Workers' Compensation Claims, a term defined in the associated motion to include claims under the BLBA, and authorized the Debtors to honor their obligations on such claims. The Debtors addressed BLBA obligations in the ordinary course following the entry of that order, and the Reorganized Debtors have continued to do so since emerging from Chapter 11.
- 14. Section 11.4(g) of the Plan provides that "Nothing in the Plan or the Confirmation Order, or any documents incorporated by reference herein, ... limits or in any way affects (i) the liability of the Debtors, the Reorganized Debtors, or any third party to successful claimants or the [Department of Labor] under the BLBA" This language is repeated in Paragraph 72 of the Confirmation Order.
- 15. Each of the claimants thus has full recourse to the appropriate Reorganized Debtors with respect to any valid claim under the BLBA. It is not appropriate for the claimants also to recover from the Debtors' bankruptcy estates at the expense of other creditors.
- 16. In the alternative, the Reorganized Debtors request that the Court estimate the Claims, pursuant to Section 502(c) of the Bankruptcy Code, at \$0.00 for purposes of allowance, because fixing or liquidating the Claims would unduly delay the administration of these bankruptcy cases, and no basis exists for any argument that the appropriate Reorganized Debtors will not pay obligations to the claimants as and when they come due.

WHEREFORE, the Reorganized Debtors respectfully request that this Court:

- (a) disallow the Claims, without prejudice to the claimants' rights to recover in non-bankruptcy proceedings;
- (b) in the alternative, estimate the Claims at \$0.00 for purposes of allowance; and
- (c) grant such other and further relief as is just and proper.
