Upon the notice of rejection [ECF No. 778] (the "**Notice**")¹ of Patriot Coal Corporation and its subsidiaries that are debtors and debtors in possession in these proceedings (collectively, the "**Debtors**") filed on September 20, 2012 pursuant to the Court's Order dated August 16, 2012 Establishing Procedures for the Rejection of Executory Contracts and Unexpired Leases and for the Abandonment of Personal Property [ECF No. 370] (the "**Rejection Procedures Order**"); and the Court having jurisdiction to consider the Notice and the relief requested therein pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334 and Standing Order M-61 Referring to Bankruptcy Judges for the Southern District of New York Any and All Proceedings Under Title 11, dated July 10, 1984 (Ward, Acting C.J.) as amended by Standing Order M-431, dated February 1, 2012 (Preska, C.J.); and consideration of the Notice and the requested relief being a core proceeding the Bankruptcy Court can determine pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b); and due and proper notice of the Notice having been provided in accordance with the Rejection Procedures Order; and it appearing that no other or further notice need be provided; and

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the relief requested in the Notice being in the best interests of the Debtors and their respective estates and creditors; and rejecting the Lease to the extent set forth herein representing a prudent exercise of the Debtors' business judgment; and the Court having reviewed the Notice; and upon all of the proceedings had before the Court and after due deliberation and sufficient cause appearing therefor, it is hereby

ORDERED that the relief requested in the Notice is hereby granted as set forth herein; and it is further

ORDERED that pursuant to section 365(a) of the Bankruptcy Code and Bankruptcy Rule 6006 and Local Rule 6006-1, the Debtors' rejection of the Lease set forth in Schedule A hereto (the "**Lease Agreement**") is hereby approved and shall be effective as of September 20, 2012; and it is further

ORDERED that claims arising out of any rejection effected pursuant to this Order must timely be filed in accordance with any order pursuant to Bankruptcy Rule 3003(c) establishing a deadline by which claims arising before the Petition Date must be filed (the "**Bar Date**"), on or before the later of (i) the Bar Date and (ii) 30 days after the date hereof, and that absent a timely filing, such claim will be irrevocably barred; and it is further

ORDERED that notice of the Notice and the relief requested therein with respect to the Lease Agreement satisfies Bankruptcy Rule 6006 and Local Bankruptcy Rule 6006-1; and it is further

ORDERED that the notice procedures set forth in the Notice with respect to the Lease Agreement are good and sufficient notice and satisfy Bankruptcy Rule 9014

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by providing the counterparty to the Lease Agreement with notice and an opportunity to

object and be heard at a hearing; and it is further

ORDERED that this Court shall retain jurisdiction to hear and determine

all matters arising from or related to this Order.
