After 20 years of service to Peabody, they promise us our pension and our medical, and now they want to take that away from us. Many miners have up to 40 years or more.

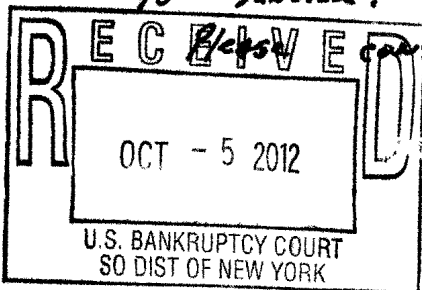
Companies should not have the right to start smaller companies and put us under their company name then file for bankruptcy, while the main company Peabody is still making millions each year.

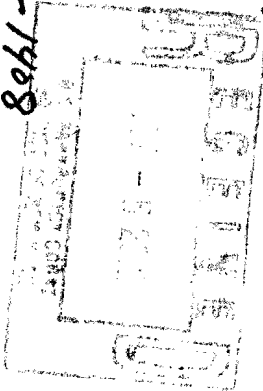

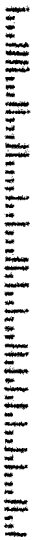
