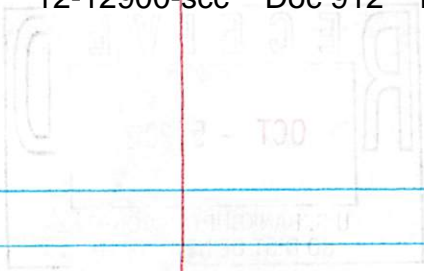


Honorable Shelley C. Chapman
