

To: The Honorable Shelly C. Chapman

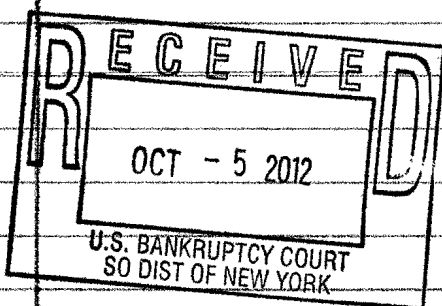

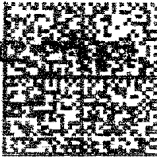
