In my case my wife and I would loose
our Insurance and Prescription Medicine.

I am 80 years old and my wife is 78 years old.
We are not in very good health, as our
Medicine bills will attest to. My Prescription
Medicine for 1/1/12 to 10/1/12 was \$5614.11.

My wife Prescription bill for 1/1/12 to 10/1/12 was \$920.93.

I have had Cataract Surgery in both eyes,
Nerves in my back burned three time, I have
had to have a lot of therapy for my legs and
back. I was in the Hospital four days with
Gout, then 30 days at Nursing Home for Rehabilitation.

I take medicine for Congestive Heart failure, Thyroid Problems, Diabetes, Kidney failure, over active Bladder, Hypertension, Arthritis, Gout, and Pain.

My wife is on Medicine for Congestive Heart failure, Hypertension, Albuterol Inhaler for her breathing, Atrial Fibrillation, and takes Coumadin she has to have a blood test once a month and some times more often to keep check on her, Prothrombin time (PT and INR).

Medicine for my heart and Pain.

We also have Doctor Bills not listed here.

If we loose our Insurance and Prescription Medicine I don't know what we will do.

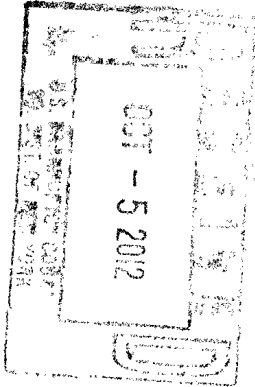
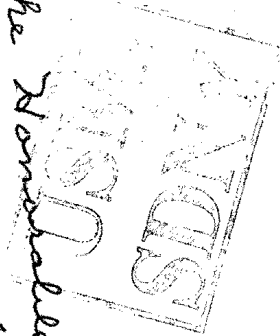

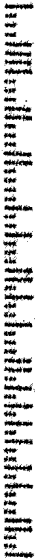
